Word and Publisher files are not acceptable as finished artwork and will have to be converted by our designer. In this case fonts will be matched as closely as possible.

We can accept artwork in the following formats:

CMYK print quality PDF files with all fonts embedded

CMYK TIFFs, JPEGs or EPSs with a minimum image resolution of 300 dpi.

CMYK EPS files from Illustrator / Freehand / other illustration applications with all text converted to curves/outlines and all imagery embedded.

Advertisement artwork should be supplied at the correct size and orientation according to the above table.

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
